It is the mission of West Contra Costa Unified School District, in partnership with staff, parents, students, and the community, to provide a quality educational program for all students. We strive to help students develop the knowledge, skills, abilities, and attitudes necessary to realize their full potential.

We have two purposes in establishing a district discipline plan: (1) to promote learning and growth for students as they develop (2) to provide a caring and respectful environment for all. Only in such an environment can our children become the responsible future.

To achieve these goals, students must understand their rights and adhere to their responsibilities.

Student Rights:

- x To be safe. We need to guarantee that students have the best environment conducive to learning.
- x To be respected and treated with compassion, courtesy, and dignity regardless of race/ethnic background, origin, religion, national physical/mental disability, sexual orientation, family structure, political beliefs, physical appearance, or financial status.
- x
