## What Most Children Do at this Age:

### Social/Emotional

- Want to please friend
- Want to be like friend
- More likely to agree with rule
- Like to sing, dance, and act
- Aware of gender
- Can tell what's real and what's make-believe
- Show more independence for example, may visit a next-door neighbor or stay him/herself [adult supervision until needed]
- Sometimes demanding and sometimes very cooperative

### Languages/Communication

- Speak very clearly
- Tell a simple story using full sentence
- Use future tense; for example, "Grandma will be here."
- Say name and address

### Cognitive (learning, thinking, problem-solving)

- Count 10 or more things
- Can draw a person with at least 6 body parts
- Can print some letters or numbers
- Copy a triangle and other geometric shapes
- Know about things used every day, like money and food

### Movement/Physical Development

- Stand on one foot for 10 seconds or longer
- Hop; maybe able to skip
- Can do a somersault
- Use a fork and spoon and sometimes a table knife
- Can use the toilet on her own
- Swing and climb
