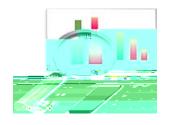

  - Will meet 3% reserve
- 2011-12
  - Will meet 3% reserve
  - Using one-time funding
- 2012-13
  - \$8.3 million projected deficit spending
  - Uses fund balance
  - Will meet 3% reserve

Positive Certification of Second Interim

 Budget Reductions and one-time solutions recommended for 2011-12 will result in a 3% reserve

Deficit spending projection in 2012-13 spends fund balance

#### Local Outlook

- Budget adoption occurs in June 2011
  - Must include Multi Year projection for 2012-13 and 2013-14

## Threats to Current Budget

- State Economic Crisis Continues
- Three Hurdles Remain
  - Legislature must adopt cuts to programs such as health and social services
  - Legislature must agree to place an extension of taxes on the June ballot
  - California taxpayers must agree to these taxes to preserve education
