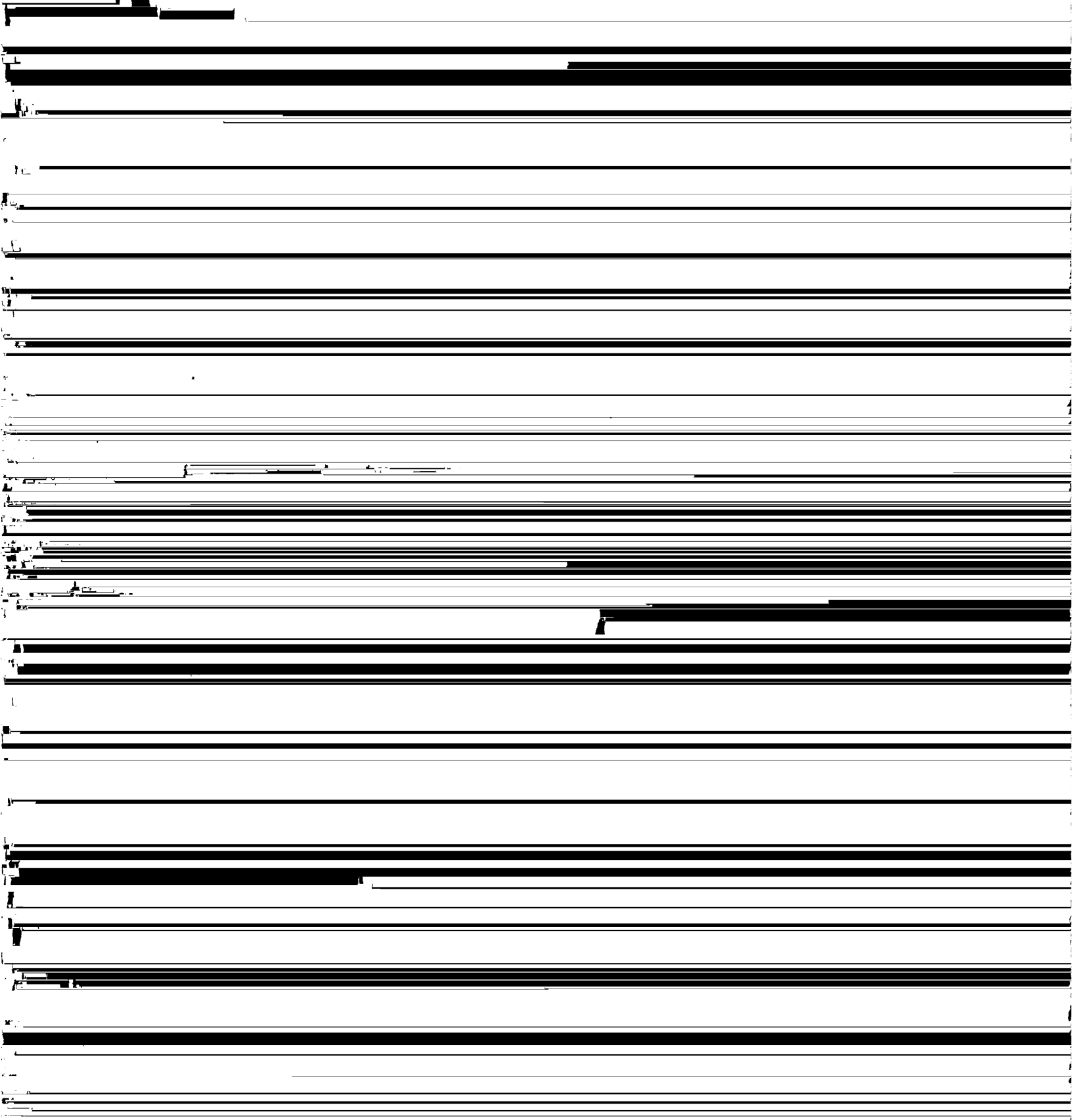

Section 2. Date and Purpose of Measure. Pursuant to Section 4 of Article XIII A of the California Constitution and Government Code Section 50077, an election shall be held within the boundaries of the District on Tuesday, November 4, 2008 for the purpose of voting on a proposition, a copy of which is attached hereto and marked Exhibit A, containing the question of whether the District shall renew its existing parcel tax for the purposes stated therein. Section 5. Resolution to County Registrar and Clerk and County Superintendent of Schools. That the Clerk of the Board is hereby directed to cause certified copies of this Resolution and Order to be delivered not later than August 8, 2008, to the Contra Costa County Superintendent of Schools and not later than August 8, 2008, to the Contra Costa County Registrar of Voters (the "County Registrar"), as the officer conducting the election, and to the Contra Costa County Clerk of the Board of Supervisors (the "County Clerk").
