Our School-Based Health Center is designed to provide a continuous stream of support services that will contribute to student well-being and academic achievement.

The Canadeo Elementary School-Based Health Center was founded during the 2015 – 16 school year as part of West Contra Costa Unified School District's 5-Hour Comprehensive School Health Initiative. The goal of the initiative is to support school success for all students.
