Change Orders are fully executed by the District upon signature by the Superintendent's designee. * D.2 Sprint Project Connect Grant

Comment:

The District was contacted March 20, 2014 by Luz Gomez, Deputy Chief of Staff from the office of Contra Costa Supervisor, John Gioia with an opportunity to take advantage of a \$100,000 Project Connect Grant sponsored through Sprint. Sprint will provide 65 Kennedy students with Dell laptops and internet connectivity for 2 years. These students have little or no technology at home and were selected based on this need. Students will not need to return these laptops and may use them beyond high school.

Kennedy administrators and technology teacher La Rue Moore have created a new class section which will provide these students the instruction needed to use technology successfully and develop life-long learning skills. An articulation agreement between Kennedy and Contra Costa College will allow students the ability to earn 12 CCC credits.
