On Monday I will be meeting with Board President Enos and Board Clerk Block to work on agenda setting for the joint School Board/CBOC meeting on March 30th.

The CBOC Audit Subcommittee is very concerned about the 2015 Bond Performance Audit for the bonds. The School Board has an obligation to receive the Performance Audit by March 31. In the past the CBOC has always given the Board a recommendation on the Performance Audit. The CBOC's recommendation originates in the Audit Subcommittee, where over the years a number of errors and discrepancies have been identified and corrected before the Performance Audit left the subcommittee. The CBOC is supposed to receive a draft of the Performance Audit at the same time as it is received by the District. Today is March 15 and we still have not yet seen a draft of the Performance Audit. So it is likely that at the next Board meeting you will be asked to receive a Performance Audit without a recommendation from the CBOC and then a month or two later you may be presented with a new version of the Performance Audit with a recommendation from the CBOC. I doubt that the CBOC Audit Subcommittee would be in favor of renewing the current audit firm's option to do the Performance Audit again next year.
