High School Plan Developed

In the Fall of 2014, 1024 total students were initially contacted through our classroom guidance presentations on graduation requirements and postsecondary options. Counselors then conducted a one on one counseling session with each individual students presenting them with De Anza's four year plan which correlates to the A-G sequence to their high school plan. In the Spring of 2015, we have met with 862 total students who have developed their individual high school plan. Overall, this showed that we have helped developed a high school plan with 84% of our student population.

The data comes from an intentional guidance lesson we did for all students 9-12th grades. We reached a total of 1024 students during the Fall of 2014. Using the data collected from the pre test, 723 students total who agree/strongly agree that they know what they need to do for the A-G course sequence and minimum h agree/strongl
