

6. Is there a financial way to determine whether a K-8 proposal would be cost neutral?

Answer: If the District were to add seats for 7th and 8th graders at a school that is currently K-6, the number of seats would be limited by the space available and number of parents requesting to transfer their students into the K-8 school. By operating the K-8 as the district does current elementary schools, the K-8 school would be 'cost neutral.' No financial analysis is available at this time.
